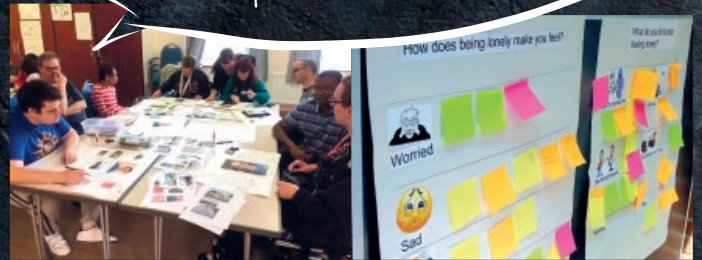
A SELF ADVOCACY GROUP FOR PEOPLE WITH A LEARNING DISABILITY AT A COMMUNITY VENUE IN BASINGSTOKE

The group started in 2006 as part of the HCC learning disability day services. Speakeasy became partners later that year to support the development of the group. By 2010 it was run independently by Speakeasy with a membership of 30 people.

FRIENDSHIP

- Meet up with old friends and make new friends too!
- Use the buddy scheme to help you try something new

- Referral by local authority social worker or health case manager
- £25 per day as part of an agreed care provision
- Low level support provided during the day (additional support may be required for specialist or 1:1 support)
